ENTRY FEES:

Entry Fees are calculated by adding up the total number of runs for all dogs in your family (i.e. those registered to family members and living in the same household under the same roof).

1 to 6 runs \$8.00 7 to 12 runs \$7.50 13 or more runs \$7.00

Day of Show \$11.00 per run

HOW TO SUBMIT AN ENTRY TO THIS TRIAL:

PAYMENT OPTIONS WHEN SUBMITTING YOUR ENTRY FORM ARE;

Send cheque/money order via Australia Post, Direct Deposit or Paypal.

Exhibitors wanting to post payment must not print out the electronic form.your form is submitted electronically when you fill it out. Only your payment is sent via Australia Post.

Regardless of whether you enter via the online or postal method your entry will not be processed unless payment is received and you have signed the agreement (manually or electronically depending on your method of entry)

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- 1.1 As used here NADAC means North American Dog Agility Council and NADAC Australian Division, its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2 Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3 Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property.
- 1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5 Exhibitor/owner release NADAC (Including NADAC officers directors, employees and members), NADAC Australian Division, Blissful Paws, Paws to Consider and the City of Greater Geelong and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

In consideration of the acceptance of the entry, I/we certify that I/we have knowledge of, and are familiar with, and agree to abide by, the rules and Regulations of NADAC in effect at the time of this trial, and by any additional rules and regulations as approved by NADAC for this trial. I/we certify that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. I/We further agree to be bound by the "Agreement" as stated above and will include this signed agreement with my entry form and payment.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and anyone who is not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed entry into the trial.

****Dog(s)** must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free from the NADAC web site: www.nadac.com

THE MANAGEMENT will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his/her owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behaviour may, at the discretion of the Show Committee be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs. Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial. The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.

Judges briefing and course walk through will commence at approximately 8.00 a.m. and Judging will commence following the Judges Briefing and first course walkthrough.

IMPORTANT. Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the www.NADACForum.com within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the Forum by going to www.NADACForum.com and submitting your request. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club.

The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be recorded by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

CLUB POLICIES

- All dogs must be on leash when not competing in the ring. Dogs may not be left tethered and unattended on Trial grounds
- Crating and Shade shelters are not permitted within close proximity of the ring (ie within 20 feet of the sides or the rear of the ring and should be at least 40 feet from the front of the ring.) This is to keep the Marshalling area clear and to provide teams competing with clear ring perimeters.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire an act of God, public emergency, an act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Cheques not honoured by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$30 service charge for bank returned cheques.
- A class running order will be posted on a whiteboard ringside. There will be no posted exhibitor run order, exhibitors are invited to line up as they wish within their class. You will need to be attentive to what is happening in the ring as no-one will be calling for you. The will be a catalogue of entries available ringside if you have forgotten what you have entered.
- Handlers are responsible for ensuring that they a ringside and ready to run their dog at an appropriate time.
- No Alcoholic Beverages are allowed on the show site.
- There will be no refunds for entries in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition regardless of the reason for such dismissal.
- A withdrawal from the competition after the closing date due to an injury and/or illness of the dog and/or a bitch coming into season after the closing date will be eligible for a refund up to 75% of the total entry fee paid. A veterinarian's notice of injury or illness will be required for a refund.
- Dog Treats/Ribbons will be awarded to first through fourth places.
- All exhibitors upon entering this trial agree to assist with the running of the trial. A Job Roster will be posted on the running order board. If exhibitors come out and help then the trial will run quite efficiently. If no one helps then as main workers get tired, the trial will run late and slow. We appreciate your help and thank you in advance.
- All Blissful Paws trials are containerised trials please refer to the exhibitor handbook/website/forums for information on what a containerized trial is.
- Having fun and displaying good sportsmanship is wholeheartedly encouraged.

CATERING: There is no catering available so please make sure you bring your own food and drinks

TRIAL SITE: Is outside on grass. Please bring shade/shelter for your dogs (s)
