**Awards and Ribbons:**

Ribbons are awarded from 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> place for all classes in each height group in Standard Division. Ribbons are awarded from 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> place for all classes in each height group in combined Junior Handler, Veteran Dog and Veteran Handler Division.

Qualifying ribbons will be awarded for all qualifying runs.

Exhibitors may elect to have dog treats in lieu of ribbons – 4 Biscuits per Q and 2 Biscuits per place. This option is made available at the time of entry.

Highest in trial will be awarded for each level (Intro, Novice, Open & Elite) in the standard division and also the combined divisions of Junior and Veteran divisions.

## **JUMP HEIGHT INFO**

### **MEASURING:**

### **Dogs which require measuring:**

Dogs in the Proficient Category, Novice, Open or Elite jumping 4", 8", 12" or 16"

### **Dogs which do not need to be measured:**

Dogs jumping 16" in the Veteran or Junior Handler Division

Dogs jumping 20"

Dogs in the Skilled Category

Dogs with a permanent height card

Dogs listed on the Height Exemption List

## **JUMP HEIGHTS**

There are four Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", and 20".

There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

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## **BRIEF SUMMARY OF RULES**

Please refer to [www.nadac.com](http://www.nadac.com) for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. - Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- No collars, leads, food, toys, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course. No, food, toys, clickers within 10 feet of the ring. Food or small toys can be in a secure container in pocket during a containerized trial.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

Up to six dogs can be entered per online entry. If you are entering more than six dogs, please complete a second entry for that dog/s.

**AGREEMENT – This agreement will be on the online form for you to sign electronically.  
Your entry cannot be accepted without a signed agreement.**

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

1.1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.

1.2. Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5. Exhibitor/owner releases NADAC (including its respective officers, directors, employees, and members), **Agility Dog Club of Victoria** (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee), and Local City Council (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

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### CLUB POLICIES

- All dogs must be on leash when not competing in the ring. Dogs may not be left tethered and unattended on trial grounds.
  - Crating and shade shelters are not permitted within close proximity of the ring (i.e. within 20 feet of the sides or rear of the ring and should be at least 40 feet from the front of the ring). This is to keep the Marshalling area clear and to provide teams competing with clear ring perimeters.
  - A class running order will be posted on a whiteboard ringside. The exhibitor run order will be available ringside if you have forgotten what you have entered. There will not be a Gate Marshall calling you to the ring, so you will need to be attentive to what is happening within the ring so as not to miss your jump height. Handlers are responsible for ensuring that they are ringside and ready to run their dog at an appropriate time.
  - The club reserves the right to change the running order on the day upon consultation with the Judge and Trial Secretary.
  - No Alcoholic Beverages are allowed on the show site.
  - All Agility Dog Club of Victoria NADAC trials are containerized trials – please refer to the exhibitor handbook/website/forums for information on what a containerized trial is.
  - Having fun and displaying good sportsmanship is wholeheartedly encouraged.

Enter and pay by no later than the entry closing date and time - 8.00pm, Friday 24<sup>th</sup> May 2019

**ENTRY FEE:** is \$8.00 per run and must be received by the trial closing time date.

Trial credit vouchers from other clubs cannot be used at this trial.
